

DIRECTIONS TO TEST:

Tuckahoe Turf Farm – Take Route I 95 South to Exit 3A. Proceed East on Rt. 138 about 1 mile to Rt. 112 South Go approximately 3.2 miles to Rt. 91. Turn right onto Rt.91 and travel 2.2 miles. You will pass a sign for the Tuckahoe Turf Farm office and the Meadowbrook Fishing Pond. Turn right onto Switch Rd. After .1 miles, just after the regional school complex, turn left onto an unmarked dirt access road immediately after a chain link fence. Proceed to the test site, which will be marked. Park along the road. The site is about 35 minutes from the host hotel.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

In accordance with AKC Regulations, entries in this tracking test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached.

A drawing will be held at the home of the Secretary, Karen Oliver, 3 Alcorn Rd., Chelmsford, MA 01824 on Wednesday, April 22 at 8:00 pm. to determine which entries will participate in the test.

This drawing, conducted by the test secretary, shall be completely at random from among the entries received, except that preference shall be given to those entries which have not earned a TD title for the TD Test. All Tracking Dog (TD) Test entries must be accompanied by a certification, according to Chapter 3, Section 2 of the Tracking Regulations.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the alternate list, subject to the same preferences set forth above.

The test secretary shall notify all entries of the result of the drawing. Alternates have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those who opt to decline shall have their entry fees returned upon written notification of the test secretary of their intention to withdraw from the alternate list.

In the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing of entries, the test secretary shall contact alternates in the order of their placement on the alternate list. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option to accept or decline the opportunity to participate in the test.

No entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate in the test. Exception: In the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and an alternate replaces that entry, refund will be made to the withdrawn entry.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the test secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates will participate.

- 1.(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering. i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.) Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired). Collies (rough, smooth). Bull Terriers (colored, white). Manchester Terriers (standard, toy). Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat). English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2.The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3.(Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4.A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
